### **WRITING**

**Key question**: How do authors use clauses to position the audience to successfully achieve their writing purpose?

- Strategies:
  - Modelled writing samples, success criteria, individual learning goals, feedback (Bump it up walls)
  - Use the language of transitivity for the key elements of clauses and sentences to compose effective simple, compound and complex sentences
  - Understand how text patterns are used to position the audience to achieve the purpose of the text
  - Inquiry cycles to track student progress, identify high yield strategies, differentiate instruction
  - Apply the writing process to successfully compost texts

#### Inclusion

**Key question**: How are we ensuring the learning success of all students?

- Strategies:
  - Use data including student work samples, literacy continuum, Early Start data and Achievement Standards to determine student's learning level and identify the next steps for individual students
  - Differentiate assessment at planning to ensure a clear line of sight for learning
  - Use modelled samples, success criteria, learning goals and feedback to guide student's learning
  - Implement Tiers of support through Whole School Framework for Differentiated Teaching and Learning Framework to maximise the potential of all students
